## Script Score

### 1. Character Development: 8/10

The characters are well-developed, particularly Peace and Sage. We see clear emotional arcs and motivations for most characters. The relationships between characters feel authentic, and each member of the Brohemians has distinct personalities and backstories that contribute to the overall narrative.

### 2. Plot Construction: 7/10

The story follows a clear three-act structure with escalating stakes. The plot moves at a good pace and builds tension effectively. However, some plot points feel a bit convenient, and the final resolution might be too metaphysical for some audiences. The action sequences are well-constructed and serve the story.

### 3. Dialogue: 7/10

The dialogue is generally natural and serves character development well. Each character has a distinct voice. However, some exposition through dialogue feels a bit forced, particularly in the early scenes. The banter between the Brohemians feels authentic and helps establish their relationships.

### 4. Originality: 8/10

The concept of peace as a chemical formula combined with parkour action sequences and youth counterculture creates a

unique blend. The story takes familiar elements but combines them in fresh ways. The ending is particularly bold and unexpected.

#### 5. Emotional Engagement: 9/10

The script successfully creates strong emotional investment in the characters and their mission. The relationships between characters, particularly Peace and Jen, and Sage with his father, are touching and well-developed. The sacrifice scenes are particularly powerful.

#### 6. Theme and Message: 8/10

The themes of peace, acceptance, and the power of choice are well-integrated throughout the story. The message about the possibility of change and the importance of leadership in achieving peace is clearly conveyed without being too heavy-handed.

### **Synopsis**

As Peace glows brighter, she transforms into a being of pure energy. The light washes over everyone, giving them a permanent sense of inner peace. Huey realizes Peace has sacrificed herself to pass on her gift to the world.

### **Plot Assessment and Enhancement**

What's working well:

- The concept of a formula/power that can bring permanent peace to people is intriguing and has a lot of potential. Peace is a compelling protagonist with noble goals.
- The group of friends/allies (the "Brohemians") that supports Peace brings humor, heart, and action to the story. Their parkour skills allow for exciting action sequences.
- There are clear antagonists pursuing Peace, raising the stakes - the corrupt government agents and violent drug cartel pose credible threats.
- The climax where Peace gets to address the world leaders is the payoff we're waiting for, a chance for her message to be heard on the global stage.

What could be improved:

- The ending feels abrupt with Peace transforming into the ball of light. More clarity is needed on what exactly happens to her and what impact it has. Does she sacrifice herself? Does the light spread peace? It's unclear.
- There are perhaps a few too many antagonists (government agents, cartel, etc.) which splits the focus. Streamlining to one core threat may help.
- Sage's backstory and motivations could use more development so his sacrifice feels more impactful.
- Payton's side story of dropping out of medical school, while interesting, may not tie closely enough to the central plot.

- Some scenes feel overly expository with characters explaining the plot or backstories at length. Finding more visual ways to convey information could help.

Overall it has a fun premise and many working parts centered around an important theme. With some refinements to clarify character motivations, simplify plot threads, and strengthen the climax, it could be very compelling.
